

The Technische Universität Darmstadt (TU Darmstadt) invites applications for the position of a

**Full University Professorship (W3) in "Science and Technology for Peace and Security" - Endowed "Georg Zundel" Professorship (Ref.No. 225)**

The position will be funded by a partnership of the "German Foundation for Peace Research" and the "Berghof Foundation for Peace and Conflict Management". It aims at strengthening research and teaching in the interdisciplinary field of science-oriented peace research as developed by the Interdisciplinary Research Group in Science, Technology and Security (IANUS) at the TU Darmstadt.

Applicants should have a strong research background in biology, chemistry or - alternatively - in physics. Furthermore, candidates are expected to demonstrate an excellent track record in the area of science-oriented peace research with very good disciplinary qualifications (habilitation or equivalent scientific achievements), significant teaching experience and an established interdisciplinary profile. The successful candidate will be jointly appointed in one of the Natural Science Departments and in the Dept. of Humanities and Historical Sciences at the TU Darmstadt. Cooperation with IANUS and a contribution to both, disciplinary and interdisciplinary research and teaching is expected.

The position is tenured with a remuneration package commensurate with experience and qualifications, following the German "W-Besoldung" category. The regulations for employment are specified under §§ 70 and 71 HHG (Hessisches Hochschulgesetz). Candidates who hold a public servant status (Beamtenverhältnis) can be reappointed under the same status. Non-permanent contracts can be altered to a permanent one after positive evaluation. The TU Darmstadt is an equity employer and encourages applications from women and persons with disabilities. Disabled people with the same qualifications will be given priority.
